UNANIMOUS WRITTEN CONSENT OF DIRECTORS IN LIEU OF SPECIAL MEETING RIDGESTONE HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION

Recitals

- 1. The Board of Directors has determined that it is in the best interest of the Association to review the current fire monitoring scope of services and undergo a request for proposals to other companies suited to the work necessary to maintain the common element per standards set.
- 2. The Board of Directors has determined that it is in the best interest of the Association to discontinue services by ProComm and Century Link for the analog system on thirteen (13) existing buildings at an annual cost of \$20,344 to monitor the fire system.
- 3. The Board of Directors has determined that it is in the best interest of the Association to retain Olympic Security and Communication Systems to monitor the existing thirteen (13) buildings and fire alarm maintenance at an annual cost of \$11,232 (+ tax)and all future buildings at an annual cost of \$864.00 (+tax) per building.

BE IT RESOLVED that the proposal by Olympic Security and Communication Systems for \$864 (+ tax) per building to monitor and inspect all existing and future buildings is accepted.
